

CRI Outreach Middle School Indoor Rowing Coach

Summary

CRI is searching for part-time Middle School Indoor Rowing coaches for Let's Row Boston, a Physical Education partnership with Boston Public Schools. This position requires an energetic personality that engages youth in sport and builds excitement for additional rowing opportunities in CRI's Row Boston program. This is a part-time position with the opportunity to expand work with other CRI programs and teams.

Goals of a Middle School Indoor Rowing Coach

- Increase daily physical activity opportunities and introduce a new sport to thousands of BPS youth annually.
- Increase the capacity of PE teachers throughout Boston to use our indoor rowing curriculum with reduced oversight from CRI's staff.
- Promote the Youth Erg Trials International (YETI), the Mike Moran Cup, and free learn-to-row summer clinics at CRI.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Coaching
 - Coach indoor rowing classes with school's Physical Education staff
 - Coach middle school students in 12-person rowing barges during field trips.
 - Train Physical Education staff at all new partner schools.
- Scheduling and Coordination
 - Coach classes within a typical Boston Public School day schedule of 7:30am-3:00pm (schedules may vary within school). Candidates will be considered if available to work either a morning schedule (7:30am-2:30pm) or evening schedule (2:00pm-6:30 pm), if necessary.
 - Transport machines between schools and ensure each school has enough quality machines.
- Compliance
 - Complete CORI and SafeSport before working at any school.
 - Comply with BPS guidelines for in-class lesson plans.
 - Accommodate BPS Wellness Office criteria for goals at each school.
 - Comply with Charles River rules of rowing as well as CRI and USRowing policies.

Skills & Requirements

- High energy individual with a passion for working with youth in cities.
- Models positive behavior for youth and staff.
- Spanish fluency is desired but not required.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Comfortable teaching rowing technique and engaging middle school students in physical fitness activities
- Ability to be flexible as a guest instructor within different PE environments.
- Hours are flexible and will fall between 7:30am and 6:00pm.

Physical Requirements

- Ability to carry indoor rowing machines individually in order to safely transport ergs between schools, and load machines into trucks and trailers (~60 lbs each)
- Ability to project your voice to a class in a gymnasium and engage youth for an entire PE class.
- Ability to stand for 60-80 minute classes
